There are some ways to find out our wealth condition in astrology through fortuna, Pushkara navamsam and indu lagna. Dhana yogas point out our wealth status. Pushkara navamsam is the one of the best way to identify the native is fortunate or unfortunate.

**Introduction:**

Money is essential for human life. In astrology Second bhava indicates one's wealth condition. The second bhava is called dhana sthana, vakku (words) sthana, family sthana, nethra (eye) sthana and taste (rushhi) sthana. Jupiter is the planet for wealth. The Second bhava lord and Jupiter decide one's wealth. 2/5/8/11 bhavas are called panaparasthana (Dhana kendra). 2/6/10 bhavas are called karma trine. We can calculate one's wealth by seeing the weightage of the above bhavas.

**Fortuna (Most Fortune Point):**

(Lagna degree + Moon degree) – Sun degree

It is called fortuna point. The fortuna point gives the most fortune to all. Fortuna point stays in lagna at amavasya thithi. It stays in second bhava at thirithyai thithi. It stays in third bhava at panchami thithi. It stays in fourth bhava at sapthami thithi. It stays in fifth bhava at navami thithi.

**Indu Lagna:**

Indu lagna is an another fortune point to indicate one's wealth. Mahakavi kalidasar explained in Uthrakalamirtha how to calculate indu lagnam. Planets dimension numbers for Sun - 30, Moon - 16, Mars - 6, Mercury - 8, Jupiter - 10, Venus - 12, Saturn - 1.

**How to Calculate Indu Lagnam?**

Indu means moon. First of all we can identify the ninth lord from rasi and lagna. Add both the planets dimension numbers and divide it by 12. Count the balance number from moon, coming rasi is called Indu lagnam. In this house any benefit planets, one should be an crorepathi. Any malefic planets in indu lagna, one should be a lakshathipathi. Money would come in the dasa of the standing planets in indu lagna.

**Pushkara Navamsam:**

The Pushkara in the Sanskrit language means the Sacred. We must have heard about the words Pushkarani or the Holy water tanks or holy rivers in the temples. Here also the word Pushkara means the Valuable worthy and auspicious. There are totally 24 Pushkara Navamsa points among the 108 Navamsa divisions which are noteworthy and called as the Pushkara Navamsa points or degrees or places. Each rasi division consisting of two Pushkara Navamsa degrees. Of the nine planets, the stars of the Mars, the Mercury and the Ketu do not possess the Pushkara Navamsa points. There are 6 Pushkara Navamsa places for the stars of the Sun. Similarly, there are 6 places for the stars of the Jupiter. Three star pada for each of the three star pada of the Venus, the Saturn, the Moon and the Rahu respectively. So totally there are 24 Pushkara Navamsa points and they are evenly distributed among the 12 zodiac signs, with each sign carrying two Pushkara Navamsa points. The 24 Pushkara Navamsa star pada are tabulated below for better clarity and understanding. It can be observed that the Pushkara Navamsa are placed in the houses of the auspicious planets like the Moon, the Mercury, the Jupiter and the Venus only in the Navamsa chart D 9. When the Pushkara Navamsa is placed in the 6th, 8th and 12th to the sign where it is placed in the Rasi chart, it will give adverse effects also at the same time when it bestows name and fame to the native.

**Traditional Astrology:**

In 15<sup>th</sup> century, a lyric in Jathaga Parijatham book, "Vargothamae vaa yathi pushkaram sae". In chandra kala book, there were more than 20. songs about pushkaramsam.

- If dasa lord or bukthi lord stands in pushkara navamsa would be lucky
- Planets, enemies of lagna lord stands in pushkara navamsa never gives good result.
- The planet in pushkara navamsa connects with 6/8/12 is very dangerous

**National Fame:**

4th lord stands in 5th bhava or 5th lord stands in 4th bhava in pushkara navamsa gives national level fame.

**International Fame:**

9th lord stands in 10th bhava or 10th lord stands in 9th bhava in pushkara navamsa gives international level fame.
