This is also a kind of healing approach similar to curative systems like Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Naturopathy, Herbal Therapy, Aroma Therapy and Acupuncture etc., Every system has its own identity, pros and cons etc., After the incidence of Covid-19, the entire humanity is under panic about their safety and survival through modern scientific equipment presently available for the Diagnosis and Prognosis of the Disease. There is no assurance to guide the prescribed preventive methods to control the advancement of the disease. Science and spirituality make an art of partnership in search of cause and effect.

Introduction:

1. Rasis and Diseases:

What is a disease? What is the art of healing? To whom we have to treat? Either patient or disease? The question have lead to the finding of homeopathic system by Dr. SAMUEL HANEMAAN. In medical astrology malefic influences of planets, malefic Bhavas, Rasis may cause infection and chronic disease like 3rd, 6th and 8th Bhavas. In Zodiac Gemini (Mithuna), Libra (Tula) and Aquarius (Kumbha) are windy signs and they govern the breath of a person; Cancer (karkataka), Scorpio (Vrichika) and Pisces (Meena) are the watery signs. They rule the human blood. Aries (Mesha), Leo (Simha) and Sagittarius (Dhanussu) are fiery signs. They got rulership over-head, face, heart, thighs, hip. Taurus (Vrushabha), Virgo (Kanya) and Capricorn (Makara) are earthy signs. They rule throat, bowels, knees.

2. Planets Significance:

As far as concerned to Pluto, Uranus and Neptune, their role is somewhat less because Pluto takes 248 years, Uranus 84 years and Neptune 165 years. After all Human life is maximum up to 100 years.

3. Planets and Diseases:

Sun is signification for soul and general health. Moon is for mind. Mars, Jupiter for obesity and diabetes. Venus for gland and hormones. Saturn for pollution and mental aberration. Rahu for ulcers and insanity, Ketu for cataract, leprose and Suicidal tendencies. Human being is having an instinct and intuition in the entirebiological system which is beyond analysis of the present scientific system thereby astrological guidance play a key role. In Astrology 9 planets are significant for the native like Sun for Soul, Moon for Mind, Mars for surgery, Mercury for nervous system. Jupiter for obesity and diabetic. Venus for glands and hormones. Saturnfor pollution and mental aberration. Rahu for ulcer and insanity, hormones and Ketu for cataract, leprosy, suicidal tendencies.

4. Constalations and Body Part:

There are 27 stars in ZODIAC belt divided by 12 rasis/houses. Each star is having its own affinity towards the body parts. Body parts revealed by constellations are as under. For Example:

7. Astrological Diagnosis:

Astrologer's Roll:

At the time of observing birth chart, the Astrologer has to observe the planets Posited or not. **Balarishta:**

If any one of yoga occurred as stated above in birth chart the native suffer from Balarishtam. There are two varieties of Balarishtas. One is SadyoBalarishta. (if death occurred within 5 months from the date of birth); and another is Soumya Balarishta (if death occurred from 5th month to 12 years from the date of birth).

Balarishta Bhangas:

If birth place in Mesha Lagna – Balarishta took place as per planet/s posited in it. By Observing balarishta, the Astrologer has to investigate whether arishtabhanga yogas are there or not. Malefic influences on lagna, lagna lord, the Moon and the quadrant in different manner produce Balarishta. If there is a predominence of benefic influences; the afflictions disappear and get cancelled.

For Example: (1) Jupiter in Lagna-strengthen General health. (2) Jupiter in Cancer or in DhanuRasi and Meena Rasi in an angle or a kona. (3) Any of the strong Budha, Guru and Sukra in an angle, (4) Benefics are strong and malefics are weak. (5) Lagna and Moon are aspect by benefic etc., (6) having Gaja-kesariyogam.

After examining of all the above, even if there is balarishta, propitiative measures are to be advocated. The following remedies in-general can be performed.

- Propitiation for the planet causing arishtayogam.
- TilaDanam and AyushyaHoma to be performed.
- In critical stages, Mrutyumjayajapa and homa is to be performed.
- Some Anushtanas with sankalpa like recitation of Rama Raksha Shtotra, Vishnu sahasranamashtotra for which protect one can be under taken by parents to protect the child.

With a view to escape from evil effects, the father should resort to remedial measures mentioned below to promote the longevity of the child and for his protection. The father should arrange for the performance of religious rites prescribed by the incantations of mantras and offerings of oblations for the pouring ghee etc., in the Holi fire on every birth day of the child (according to the Lunar month) till the 12th year. This should be supplemented by appropriate medical treatment where-ever-necessary. (Phaladeepika Chapter 13-5th sloka).

8. Diseases and Health Conditions of the Native:

For any health of the native's Lagna and Lagna Lord should be a benefic one and in lagna malefic planet may not be posited. Lagna should also be free from the axis of the malefic planets. If Jupiter is posited in lagna, the native's health condition may be in safe side. Because the lagna is first house as well as kendra and kona house. As per medical astrology, lagna is represented as physician's presence indicates.

9. Houses Indicates Diseases:

9(i) 6th House: According to sage PARASARA, 6th house represents worries and anxieties, fear of calamities, wounds. According to RUDRA all diseases arising out of one or more of the three humours such as "Vaata, Pitta and Kapha". According to UTTARA KALAMRUTA, the health of the human body is affected by dysentery, swelling of any part of the body, wounds, boils, sickness, eye troubles, urinary and venereal diseases, gout, fall from a boat, mental worries etc., Mars is a benefic karaka of 6th house and its karakatwa includes combative and general success, fame and courage and also superior strength. Planets in 6th house and their result

9(ii) Planets in 8th house and their results: The significance of 8th house is meant for evil afflictions in matters of health, the 8th house stands for chronicity, impurability complications and death also. Various planets by owning or occupying by 8th house incurability.

Surya – Fire, Burns.
Chandra – Water drowning.
Kuja – Weapon, sword, operation.
Budha – Febrile illness.
Guru – Imbalance of three doshas i.e., Vaata, Pitta, Kapha
Sukra – lack of nutrition, Venerable disease.
Seni-Thitst, dehydration.
Rahu – Gout and Rheumatism.
Ketu – Disease of private parts.

9(iii) PLANETS IN 12th house and their result:- (i) 12th house and its lord can attainmaraka nature or death inflicting capacity. This house also deals with physical illness, disturbed sleep, exhaustion, mental imbalance, hospitalization, left eye, feet and death.

(ii) Planets Posited in 12th House and their Result

Sukra –. Weak eyes
Seni Pre-mature decay of teeth, Eye-sight
Rahu – Adverse location for health, suffers from diseases such as Oedema, Difficult
to diagnose, ill-ness (diagnosis)
Ketu – Hospitalization. There are ailments of the feet, in the regions of
navel and anus and in the eye.

10. Conclusion:

Clinical diagnose has to go through the stages of a differential diagnosis, a provisional and eventually a final diagnosis. The Astrological diagnose also needs a similar methodological approach. So, an Astrologer should have through knowledge of diseases of the houses, planets and stars and also the investigation of the native's ill-health. Diagnosis may fit to say horoscope is a kind of stethoscope for the astrologer to investigate chronic and acute illnesses.

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
