Abstract:

The word 'Promotion' implied one's recognition of profession. The promotion in one's career depends upon the Karma's of his birth chart. The sincere employee will feel happy only if his work is recognized. Otherwise he will feel sorrowfulness in his/life. Let us analyse the karmas for promotions based on one's horoscope.

Introduction:

In social and political life, the 10th house, 10th Lord are for obvious reasons automatically occupy the stage of the analysis. These two parameters in a birth chart determine the height of the rise, success and failure in all our gainful economic activity. All planets gain optimum potency in the 10th house provided they are strong. The Sun and the Mars have directional strength in the 10th house, Jupiter and Mercury, being the natural significators give good results when they occupy the zenith of a birth chart. Saturn in the 10th can raise a man to dizzy heights of stress. Even Venus and the Moon, though being devoid of the directional strength in that house. All the planets transiting through the meridian of a chart contribute benefit dots to it. In fact it is possible to predict promotions in career provided the birth chart is properly analyzed keeping the 10th house and its lord of the centre because once horoscope is looked at from all angles, one can assess the extent to which the 10th Lord either directly or indirectly has been able to activate the horoscope for bearing fruit at the most opportune moment.

For example, when we take the 10th house, a planet occupies the 10th house, the 10th Lord becomes automatically its sign depositor. As a result, the planet in its own Dasa in the Bhukthi of the 10th Lord is very likely to give effects of the 10th house provided such Dasa and Bhukthi lords are friendly to each other and Bhukthi Lord is congenially placed from the Dasa Lord. The term 'congenial placement' will be discussed in later paragraph. Otherwise there may be results but such results may be adverse in the form of setbacks in career etc. Several variants of this simple rule may be imagined. Thus planet in the 10th house in the Bhukthi of a friendly planet conjoined with the 10th Lord may give similar results as mentioned above or the 10th Lord in the Dasa or the Bhukthi of a friendly planet in the 10th house, etc.

The above rule can be applied in the following birth chart:

Balance Raghu Dasa 0 Years 6 Months 24 days.

During the year 1951, the person got a big lift in service during Mercury/Mars. The Dasa Lord Mercury is in the 10th house conjoined with the exalted Sun, the Karaka for service. The Bhukthi Lord being the dispositor of the Dasa is placed in the 11th house. Hence Dasa/Bhukthi results promotions. The promotion was a reputed one because both the Dasa and Bhukti Lords are placed strong and well supported with other strategic planets in the chart. The illustration therefore suffices to prove that a planet in the 10th house inherits traits and qualities of the 10th Lord which are best expressed through the 10th Lord itself.

Moreover from examining the nature and strength of planets placed in the 10th house, it becomes necessary in an exercise on promotion prediction to assess the type of aspects the 10th house has been receiving from all planets in the chart. This is because a planet in its own Dasa gives very much effects of its aspect on different houses. In connection with this specific aspect effect it may be said that the 10th Lord aspect on the 10th house is always good. A malefic's aspect on the 10th house harms prospect of that house and spoils planets posited there, unless the aspected house is of its own. A benefic, especially Jupiter, boosts attributes and qualities of the 10th house through its aspect. So it is clear that a powerful

planet in the 10th house totally aspected by a powerful Jupiter is an excellent sign for a good career. If a planet applies aspects on a certain house, effects of such aspects are being experienced by the native throughout his life but such effects have been observed to gain greater prominence during its own Dasa and own Bhukthi of the aspecting planet. Logically therefore, it follows that a planet's aspect on the 10th house in a birth chart will produce results good or bad – during its own Dasa and Bhukthi. The following chart illustrates the same:

Balance Venus Dasa 16 Years 11 Months 4 days.

The above native of the horoscope was previous working in an unorganized sector, switched over to a Government job with better pay and service conditions in 1955 when his Mars Dasa just started. Here Mars in this birth chart is seen applying its 8th aspect on the 10th house, its own house. Again no sooner Jupiter Dasa has commenced in 1980, the native got another promotion in service. It has become possible because of the benign Jupiter's trinal aspect on the 10th house. The native enjoyed a calm and quite service life without any ripples and it culminated in a promotion during the planet's own Dasa and own Bhukthi. It may be mentioned in this connection that Mars and Jupiter besides giving promotions in service also distributed other results to the native but in their respective Bhukti's, aspect effect dominated the scene.

Thirdly, the location and strength of the 10th Lord in a birth chart merits rational appraisal. There are houses which are supportive of the traits of the 10th house. We may call these houses and their lords as requisite complements to the 10th house and the 10th lord. If the 10th Lord happens to fall in any one of these houses or these house lords occupy the 10th house or if these house lords distribute themselves among these houses in a birth chart, best results relating to the service and profession may be obtained. Take for instance, the 11th house which represents the 2nd house from the 10th i.e. the house where the services of labour are deposited or conserved. The 2nd and 10th houses are trinally connected with the 10th house. The 2nd house being 5th from the 10th denotes recognition in career while the 6th house being the 9th from the 10th denotes recognition in career while the 6th house being the 9th from the 10th governs general status in service.

Next comes the 7th house which is the 10th from the 10th. The 10th Lord to the 7th means the Bhava Lord is in a house which is equidistant from the Bhava as the Bhava itself is from the Ascendant. This fulfills the conditionality of the principle of Bhavath Bhavam. Accordingly, we must judge boss's favour from the 7th House. Lastly, the 8th house. Being the 11th house from the 10th it determines current income from service and profession. Hence, these 5 houses viz., 2nd, 6th, 7th, 8th and 11th may be called supportive of the 10th house. These houses along with the 10th house comprise a 'highly charged' field. The greater the degree of concentration of their lords within that field, the better will be the horoscope from the point of view of career of the native. Some other horoscopes where the 10th lord is so posited as to influence both the Dasa and Bhukthi Lord. If the Dasa and Bhukthi lords are friendly to each other, their interactions may reach in a breakthrough in career. For Example:

The native of the above chart has achieved a significant breakthrough in his career when he got the Bhukthi of Venus in the Dasa of Raghu. Besides in the entire Raghu-Venus period, he became a very important person in his place of work. The Dasa lord, Raghu is locked in a reciprocal aspect relationship with the 10th lord Mars and the Bhukthi Lord Venus is conjoined with the 10th lord Mars. Besides, Raghu and Venus are best friends. Moreover Raghu is conjoined with the Ascendent lord Moon and receives trinal aspects from the 9th lord Jupiter. Several variants of this simple model are possible. In some horoscope both the Dasa and Bhukthi lords friendly to each other may be seen conjoined and placed opposite to the 10th lord and their dispositor is found posited in the 10th house.

In some other horoscopes, the Dasa lord may be opposed to a planet in the 10th house and its dispositor as the Bhukthi lord conjoined with the 10th lord and so on. So to discard a horoscope on the

plea that it has neither any planet in the 10th house nor will it the Dasa of the 10th Lord would be an erroneous approach. It is said in astrology if you do not get the Dasa of a planet in your life, results expected of it may be obtained in the Dasa of another planet which is situated with the 4th or 10th house from that planet in the birth chart. In a nutshell, planets on square in each other also become Karakas for each other.

Conclusion:

Assuming the Karma for rise in career is strongly promised in the horoscope, such promises are fulfilled through appropriate Dasa and Bhuktis. For those fortunate persons rise becomes sustained and continuous in the service. Once when George Bush of Ex-president of America expressed his feelings, during the Interview with the Press people, in reply to a question that 'Are you satisfied with the Post?', he immediately said "NO BECAUSE THERE IS NO PROMOTION IN THIS POST". From the above it is understood that a promotion in his career is a must for satisfied life which depends upon the Karma of an individual.
